Dear Teachers:

The **National Math Foundation** (NMF) is seeking passionate educators interested in kinesthetic learning and engaging children through child-centered learning activities. Our NMF Summer Institute for teachers will **be held at Ithaca College, Ithaca, NY, on August 8-11, 2016**. We are pleased to announce we are seeking nominations for **2016 Scholarships for Tompkins County teachers (Round 2 deadline: February 29, 2016).** We offer full or partial scholarships through partnerships with regional funders. This is an ideal program for physical education teachers, math coaches, or PK-5 elementary teachers (although teachers of all grade levels may attend).

Eligibility Criteria

- Working full or part-time at a public or private school as of Fall, 2016. (New teachers ARE eligible.) Scholarships are awarded based on:
 - Demonstrated innovation in teaching
 - o Demonstrated willingness to incorporate kinesthetic strategies
 - Demonstrated willingness to collect and report data to NMF or participate in one of our data collection programs

Awards

- Awards may be full or partial, and will cover the cost of tuition and textbooks only.
- A registration fee of \$50 is required but may be paid by individual, school, district, PTO or a sponsor.

Application Process

- Principals or administrators must nominate teachers. Applicants will be evaluated according to criteria
 and personal attributes, including innovation and passion for teaching and will complete a brief
 interview with a member of our selection committee.
- Applicants will be notified within 30 days after application. The first round will be awarded by February 8, 2015. If additional scholarships become available, NMF will continue to award on an ongoing basis; qualified nominees remain eligible.
